

St. Bon's Child Care Summer Grade School Camps 2022

These Camps are designed to help students explore their love of learning in a variety of areas. Attending camp can give your child the chance to feel more confident and take greater risks once the school year resumes in fall. Instead of experiencing summer learning loss, students can retain and build upon their learning from the previous year. These camps are for Grade School age children going into grades 1-6 of the 2022/23 school year. Mrs. Drozd and Mrs. Mac, both certified teachers, will plan and teach the camps. Each camp is limited to 15 children. Completed enrollment forms with registration fees for at least the first camp enrolled per child are due upon Enrollment. Enrollments are due back with the fee of the first camp attending by Monday, May 16 to see if we have enough children to hold each camp.

Themes for this years Camps are :

Summer Refresh - **June 13-16** *Reading, Math, Science, Art & Religion with opportunities to bake, build, and be musical. We will also do many educational movement activities and games in a fun creative way.*

How Can we Pray?- **June 20-23** *Themes we will cover this week will include: God wants us to talk to Him, Prayer is more than asking God for things, God's people have always prayed, and Jesus teaches us to pray. Activities include reading and acting out Scripture, enjoying art and games, spending time in church for journaling and worshiping through song and dance together!*

Back to School Warm Up- **July 18-21** *School will be starting soon again. Come and Freshen up your childs' reading, math, and writing skills this week. We will make learning fun with group games, large motor activities, and encouraging creativity.*

S.T.R.E.A.M- **July 25-28** **(Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Art & Math)** *This year we will be rolling up our sleeves and getting our hands into messy science experiments, and art projects. Students will develop computer skills involving math and programing, as well as basic engineering. Children will visualize and draw while listening to Bible stories. We will also create circuits with motors and sculptures in art.*

Each camp will be a nice way for children to experience the joy of academic achievement in a more supportive and low pressure environment. These summer camps offer children the chance to learn, grow, and explore new modes of thinking and doing. These summer programs will boost academic performance during the school year, help build confidence, creativity, resiliency, and they will be fun!

The fee for each camp is \$100 and includes most materials. Each camp will run from **9:30AM-2:30PM each day**. If there are extra fees or supplies needed we will inform parents the week before. Extra Days/Hours of Child Care may be added with permission from the director. We are unsure yet if lunches will be provided through the public school lunch program at this time. You will receive an email the week or two before camp with reminders and if lunches need to be brought. Children may always bring a healthy sack lunch from home that does not need to be warmed up if they prefer to eat their own lunch. Forms including an enrollment form, release form, immunization records, and permission for walks in the neighborhood are required(if not already on file). Payment for the first camp your child will attend must be included with the enrollment form. If you enroll your child in multiple camps the enrollment fee can be brought the first day of camp for subsequent camps. The minimum number is 7 per classroom. We will refund your fee if we do not meet enrollment minimums.
